



# RMHCinema



## Come to RMH Pittsburgh and show a movie on our Living Room Projector!

Bringing snacks and drinks with your DVD is a special treat for our families! All movie snacks must be commercially packaged in individual servings and served unopened unless prepared in our commercial kitchen in advance (must seek approval from Volunteer Coordinator if preparing snacks at RMH). For extra fun, our House has a popcorn machine! You can bring kernels to be popped in the machine or bagged popcorn to be popped in the PH Kitchen microwave.

## Movie Night Guidelines:

- **This opportunity works best for 1-6 volunteers as our projector room seating is limited.**
  - We ask that in the event of a full house, volunteers pull up a bean bag on the floor and give RMH Guests the couches and chairs.
- **We anticipate between 1-10 families (up to 25 people) attending the showing, but this number varies.**
  - Family attendance cannot be predicted for the movie and will vary based on medical needs.
- **New release titles seem to be the most well received by our guests, but any appropriate DVD is welcome.**
  - You can bring your favorite DVD from home and take it with you when you go, purchase a new DVD and donate it to the Charity, or use one of the DVD's in our RMH Collection.
  - Sharing the DVD Title in advanced with the volunteer coordinator can entice Family participation. (This allows us to hang a movie poster in advanced to let the families know what is playing.)
- **Movie must be G or PG (PG-13 must be approved by Volunteer and Outreach Coordinator in advance).**
- **Groups with volunteers in high school must have an adult supervisor (25+) in attendance.**
- **Snacks: Non-messy snacks that are easy to clean up and will not stain or stick to the carpet and upholstery of the theater are permitted (no chocolate, please). Non-messy candy is fine.**
  - Please plan on serving 25 people. Any snacks/drinks that are not used are always a welcome donation.
- **A donation of bottled water is the only beverage permitted in the Projector Room. Other drinks can be served but must be kept in the kitchen or dining area.**
- **When the movie ends, please make sure the Projector Room is clean before you leave. Cleaning supplies can be requested from the Front Desk Staff if needed.**

## Important Reminders:

- **You are welcome to take photos of your group while at the House; however, no children or family members may be in the picture.**
- **Please make sure all volunteers are healthy with no signs of illness and hands are always kept washed and clean, especially while handling food.**
- **Obtain parental permission before physical interaction with the children. Remember children are undergoing treatment and their immune systems may be compromised.**
- **Please remember to always keep good boundaries with our guests. Babysitting RMH children is not permitted.**
