

*In life's most difficult moments, hope shines brightest when we come **together**. Your generosity **today** is more than a gift—it's a powerful promise that no child or family will face their medical journey alone. With your support **today**, families are given more than just a place to stay—they're given comfort, care, and the strength to face **tomorrow**. Blayke and her family experienced this firsthand, calling Ronald McDonald House their home 25 times throughout her medical journey that spanned more than two years.*

Eight-year-old Blayke loves the outdoors. Whether she's kicking a ball with her younger brother Greyson or walking along the shores of Lake Erie with her family in search of beach glass, she's smiling from ear to ear enjoying every moment. Her mom, Kristy, smiles too—knowing how long they waited for days like these.

It was in the fall of 2022 when Kristy heard the words **"your daughter has leukemia."** It marked the beginning of a journey that would often take them far from home for long periods of time for Blayke's treatment. But through the uncertainty of it all, they found comfort and connection at a place they never expected - Ronald McDonald House.

"The Ronald McDonald House became a second home to us," said Kristy.

For Kristy and her family, each of their stays at Ronald McDonald House provided exactly what they needed during an incredibly difficult time—a place to rest, a comforting sense of community, and above all, the gift of being **together**.

Blayke's initial treatment kept her hospitalized for over four months. Being just steps away from her daughter meant the world to Kristy. It gave her peace of mind and allowed her to be present for every moment of Blayke's care. It also meant everything to her that Greyson could stay with them, too.

"I missed my son, and the kids missed each other. It was huge for us when we were **together,"** shared Kristy.

That sense of togetherness reached beyond their own family. Throughout every stay, Kristy and the kids formed friendships and bonds with the staff and other families. They would see families during the day at the hospital and then return to the House in the evening and all have dinner **together**. These connections with others facing similar situations provided a tremendous amount of support for all of them.




In the Spring of 2025, Blayke celebrated a significant milestone. After two and a half years of treatment, long trips back and forth and over 150 days and nights away from home, she rang the bell that symbolized the end of her cancer treatment. Surrounded by family, friends, and her medical team, this remarkable moment was filled with tears of joy for the brave young girl who triumphed over a difficult medical journey.

Though Blayke no longer requires stays at Ronald McDonald House, it remains a special place in their hearts. Blayke is rallying her family and community to collect pull tabs to help support the House that gave them so much, ensuring others have the same comfort, care, and hope that they did.

"We are so thankful to have had this amazing place in our lives during that time," said Kristy.



A Conversation with our Board President: Sheliah Heckla
